Remember Fallujah ...

In November 2004, the US – with British assistance – launched a massive assault against the Iraqi city of Fallujah, killing hundreds of civilians, forcing tens of thousands of people to flee their homes, and using white phosphorus – a substance that burns down to the bone – as a weapon. The city itself was almost totally destroyed.

Since then the US has continued to attack towns and cities across Iraq as part of its brutal – and unpopular – occupation. Fallujah itself has become a virtual police state.

Sun 29 Oct: "Unauthorised" 24-hour peace camp in Parliament Square to demand an end to the occupation

Assemble 12 noon, Parliament Square. The camp will begin with **Maya Evans** and **Milan Rai** reading the names of 100 Iraqis who have died as a result of US/UK military action in Iraq – one year after their arrest for doing this in Oct 2005. Also attending will be Nobel Peace Prize winner **Mairead Corrigan Maguire** and Iraqi novelist **Haifa Zangana**.

Please note: Under the Serious Organised Crime and Police Act participation in such an "unauthorised" demonstration is a criminal offence punishable by a fine of up to £1,000. See website or come to a legal briefing for more info.
